Why choose a Paper Course?

Practice is the key to success with the 11+. Working through papers builds familiarity and increases confidence. Our paper courses provide the perfect opportunity for students to gain exam experience alongside the support and guidance of our teaching staff.

How does a Paper Course work?

Each paper course session will be split into two parts. Within the first half of the session, your child will work through a paper (or parts of papers), and in the second half of the session, one of our tutors will go through all the answers to the questions one-by-one.

What Paper Course options are available?

Three paper courses take place throughout the year:

- ➔ Course 1 from January to April using the **CGP 9-10 Practice Papers**
- ➔ Course 2 from April to July using the **CGP 10-11 Practice Papers**
- ➔ Course 3 through August using the **Schofield & Sims 10-11 Practice Papers**

For each course, you can select whether your child will work through **GL** (Kent) papers, or **CEM** (Bexley) papers. You can also choose to attend for 20,16, 12 or 8 weeks, and you can opt for in centre or online sessions.
